- 3 O2 - essential to human life

- 11 IV fluids are often managed with one; might be in short supply
- 14 Digital medical record
- 15 Infectious agent containing RNA or DNA that replicates within cells of living hosts

- 21 Abbr: where those who are critically ill receive care

- 40 A strict isolation imposed to prevent the spread of disease
