The cost of medication is an issue for many patients and can be a significant barrier to adherence. In fact, three in ten adults report not taking their medicines as prescribed at some point in the past year because of the costs.¹ The financial burden for the US health system due to this nonadherence leads to nearly \$300B in additional expenses.²

CipherHealth's medication savings program can be offered to patients following a healthcare event, improving adherence, preventing readmissions and enhancing patient experience. It facilitates initial and ongoing prescription savings that can be used at over 70K pharmacies across the country, including health system pharmacies.

At one health system, in the first week of the program, one patient was prescribed a treatment for relapsing multiple sclerosis. With CipherHealth's program, **the health system reduced the cost of the prescription by \$8,000.**

This program lowered the retail price from \$1,001.00 to \$43.57. In addition to the initial savings, **the patient also saves over \$4,000 on their prescribed future refills.**

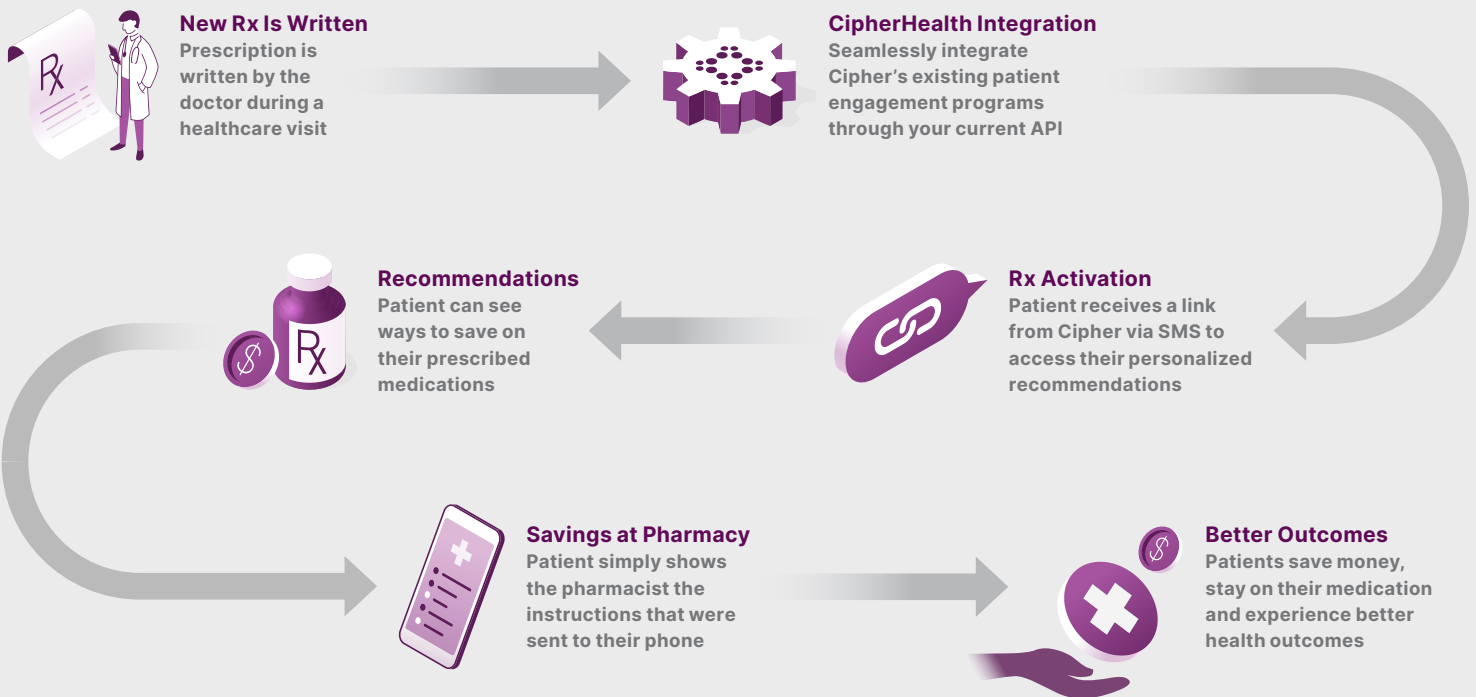
